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Arrival & Ticket Pickup

- Group Leaders will be held responsible for the actions and coordination for their group. Please make sure that everyone knows the type of behavior that will be expected of them.
- Upon arrival, park in our side tubing lot located off the left of the main driveway
- A designated group leader must be the first to arrive and check in at the blue circle yurt. Once the list of attendees and payment are verified, the leader will receive tickets for all participants to be distributed outside on the patio.
- Please have group members direct questions regarding the trip to you. If you as the group leader can't answer it please reach out to Kyle for help.

General Group Etiquette

- All tubing participants and spectators are expected to respect and follow directions given by any Nordic Mountain Employees.
- All tubing participants must exceed a height of 42"

- Under no circumstances should group participants argue or bargain with tubing employees over lane conditions, operating procedures, or a participant's height.
- The group leader is and will be held directly responsible for the actions of their group participants.
- Group participants are expected to be respectful of other guests sharing the tubing hill and keep Nordic Mountain a family friendly environment. Profanity and crude dialog will not be tolerated.
- Please stress that your students clean up their trash and leave the facilities better than they found them.
